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1. Business Results

(1) Overview of Operating Results

(Business environment)

During the six months of the consolidated fiscal year, the global economy remained highly uncertain due to factors such as developments in U.S. tariff policies, geopolitical risks centered on the Middle East and Ukraine, and shifts in monetary policy across major economies. In the United States, corporate profits were squeezed by the impact of tariff hikes, and personal consumption slowed due to worsening employment conditions. In Europe, although supported by factors such as increased fiscal spending, the economy was exerted downward pressure, particularly in the manufacturing sector, due to the impact of U.S. tariff policies. In China, although there were some signs of recovery backed by economic stimulus measures, concerns over trade tensions with the United States and prolonged downturn in the real estate market continued to constrain the pace of economic recovery. Among other emerging economies, growth remained relatively firm, particularly in Southeast Asia, although some regions experienced a slowdown due to the impact of United States tariffs. In the Japanese economy, although inbound consumption remained robust, the impact of developments in U.S. tariff policies led to sense of stagnation, particularly in the manufacturing sector.

(Overview of operating results)

In this business environment, during the six months of this consolidated fiscal year, net sales increased by 1.6% YoY, to 1,279.1 billion yen, because transaction volume mainly represented by Metal Recycling business and Overseas Sales Subsidiaries increased. Operating profit decreased by 4.0% YoY, to 27.7 billion yen, due to increased personnel expenses caused by employee increase and higher salaries. Also, ordinary profit decreased by 15.2% YoY, to 23.8 billion yen, because share of profit of entities accounted for using equity method in the Primary Metals business turned negative. Net profit attributable to owners of the parent decreased by 17.2% YoY, to 16.7 billion yen.

(Segment information)

Steel

Net sales decreased, because prices of steel products and transaction volume of steel plates decreased. On the other hand, segment profit increased, because business in the construction sector remained steady and profitability improved in some overseas subsidiaries. Net sales of this segment decreased by 7.4% YoY, to 540.6 billion yen, segment profit increased by 19.6% YoY, to 16.9 billion yen.

Primary Metal

Net sales increased, due to the steady sales of auxiliary materials. On the other hand, segment profit decreased, because share of profit of entities accounted for using equity method from SAMANCOR CHROME HOLDINGS PROPRIETARY LTD. turned negative. Net sales of this segment increased by 9.4% YoY, to 109.0 billion yen, segment loss is 1.2 billion yen (the YoY profit was 3.4 billion yen).

Metal Recycling

Net sales increased, because transaction volume of lead ores increased. Segment profit decreased due to the deterioration in the profitability of aluminum and copper. Net sales of this segment increased by 16.7% YoY, to 127.4 billion yen, segment profit decreased by 83.4% YoY, to 0.2 billion yen.

Foods

Net sales and segment profit increased due to the sales growth to food service industry in an US subsidiary and the contribution from the newly included subsidiary. Net sales of this segment increased by 8.6% YoY, to 71.5 billion yen, segment profit increased by 127.5% YoY, to 1.8 billion yen.

Energy & Living Materials

Net sales increased, due to the result of sales of wood pellets and PKS(Palm Kernel Shell). On the other hand, segment profit decreased, because the range of fuel price fluctuations was narrowed. Net sales of this segment increased by 0.8% YoY, to 185.9 billion yen, segment profit decreased by 22.9% YoY, to 3.9 billion yen.

Overseas Sales Subsidiaries

Net sales increased, due to the increase of scrap transaction to Southeast asia and the newly consolidation of companies. On the other hand, segment profit decreased due to the deterioration mainly in the profitability of steel products. Net sales of this segment increased by 19.1% YoY, to 245.3 billion yen, segment profit decreased by 9.7% YoY, to 3.3 billion yen. Other

In housing materials section, net sales and section profit decreased, due to the deterioration in the profitability of European lumber. In machinery section, net sales and section profit increased, due to the increase of completion of the industrial machinery contracts compared to the same period of the previous fiscal year. Net sales of this segment decreased by 3.4% YoY, to 63.1 billion yen, segment profit decreased by 2.3% YoY, to 1.0 billion yen.

(2) Overview of Financial Position

(Financial Position)

Total assets decreased by 3.2% to 1,128.7 billion yen from the end of the previous fiscal year, mainly due to the decrease in inventories and trade receivables.

Liabilities decreased by 5.6% to 732.7 billion yen from the end of the previous fiscal year, mainly due to the decrease in short-term borrowings and trade payables. As interest-bearing debt decreased by 5.4% to 361.6 billion yen, net debt-equity ratio was turned into 73% (*62%).

Total net assets increased by 1.7% to 396.0 billion yen from the end of the previous fiscal year due to accumulation of retained earnings from net income attributable to owners of parent as well as the increase in valuation difference on available-for-sale securities. Equity-to-asset ratio rose to 34.6% (*36.8%), from 32.9% (*35.0%) at the end of the previous fiscal year.

*Reflecting equity credit attributes of the subordinated loan

(Cash Flow)

During the six months of the consolidated fiscal year, cash flows from operating activities increased by 39.0 billion yen, mainly due to the decrease in inventories, trade receivables and contract assets. On the other hand, cash flows from investing activities decreased by 3.0 billion yen, due to payments for the acquisition of investment securities and short-term loans receivable. Cash flows from financing activities decreased by 28.1 billion yen, mainly due to repayments of borrowings. As a result, cash and cash equivalents at the end of the six months of the consolidated fiscal year increased by 12.6 billion yen from the end of the previous fiscal year to 77.9 billion yen.

We have not changed our consolidated future forecast announced on May 9, 2025.

(Note to significant changes in shareholders' equity)

The Company has acquired 713,800 shares of treasury shares during the six months ended September 30, 2025, based on the resolution of the Board of Directors meeting held on May 9, 2025. As a result of this acquisition, the amount of treasury shares increased by 4,070 million yen, resulting in treasury shares of 9,663 million yen as of September 30, 2025.

(Application of particular accounting procedures for the semi-annual consolidated financial statements) Calculation of tax expenses

Income taxes are determined based on the amount of income before income taxes for the six months ended September 30, 2025 multiplied by the effective tax rate, after application of tax-effect accounting, estimated for the entire fiscal year ending March 31, 2026. However, if using this estimated effective tax rate results in extremely unreasonable tax expenses, the statutory effective tax rate is used after adjusting net income (loss) before income taxes for material differences that are not temporary.

Acquisition of treasury shares

The Company resolved, at the Board of Directors meeting held on November 7, 2025, to acquire its own shares under Article 156 of the Corporation Law of Japan, as applied pursuant to Article 165(3) of the Corporation Law, as follows:

1. Reason

To promote return to shareholders and improve capital efficiency.

2. Details of acquisition

(1) Class of shares to be acquired: Common stock

(2) Number of shares to be acquired: Up to 1,000,000 shares

(equivalent to 2.5% of the total issued shares)

(3) Total amount of shares to be acquired: Up to 5 billion yen

Stock split and partial amendment to articles of incorporation due to stock split

The Company resolved, at the Board of Directors meeting held on November 7, 2025, to conduct a stock split and to partially amend the Articles of Incorporation in conjunction with the stock split, as follows:

1. Stock split

(1) Purpose of stock split

By conducting stock split, we aim to improve the liquidity of our shares and expand our investor base by lowering the price per investment unit.

i) Method of stock split

The Company shall conduct stock split at a ratio of five shares for every one share of common stock held by shareholders registered or recorded on the final shareholder register on Tuesday, March 31, 2026.

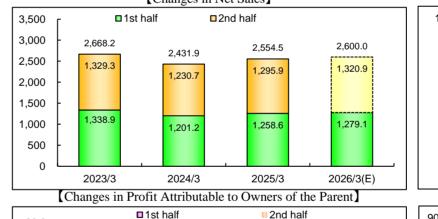

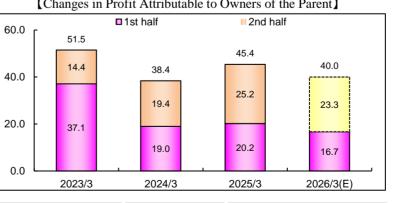

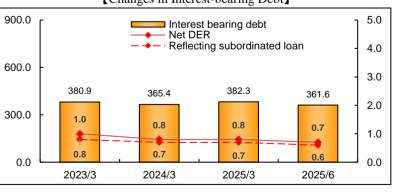
